<p><b>RESIDENTIAL</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There will be <b>no trash</b> collection service on Monday, September 2, 2019.</li> <li>• If you normally set out your household <b>trash</b> Sunday evening for Monday collection, please set your <b>trash</b> out on Monday evening for Tuesday collection.</li> <li>• All other trash routes are as scheduled.</li> <li>• <b>Do NOT set yard waste out for collection.</b></li> </ul>	
YARD WASTE COLLECTION	
<p><b>Residential</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There will be <b>no yard waste</b> collection for Neighborhood Advisory Council (NAC) 6&amp;7 on Monday, September 2, 2019. NAC 6&amp;7 yard waste collection will resume regular schedule on <b>Monday, September 9, 2019</b>.</li> <li>• <b>Do NOT set yard waste out for collection.</b></li> </ul>	<p><b>Commercial Downtown Business District</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Commercial Downtown Business trash will be collected on the normal schedule.</li> </ul>
