POLICE REPORT:

Chief Ledwell, Sgt. Rocca, Ofc. Lawson, & Ofc. Irons were in attendance to go over the below crime statistics as well as answer any questions.

The Chief said that there were about 25 cars towed during the snow storm. The Officers also said that thefts from motor vehicles continue to be a concern for residents in all areas of the city.

Keith & Zack talked about the past storm and that The City hired 5 contractor crews to help with the clearing operation. The mainly worked on the outer developments. They said it takes longer for the city to clear some areas because of the low hanging wires. The trucks have to be careful not to get caught in them. They also said that the operation turned into a snow clearing operation in the downtown area and there were some hiccups. Residents asked about trash pickup and Zack told them that it goes, unless they hear specifically that it is not, assume that it is going to be picked up.
