POLICE REPORT:

Sgt. Beliveau was in attendance and talked about the below statistics. Residents talked about some speeding concerns and Sgt. Beliveau provided the speed box data for the Chapel Alley. 99% of the cars that went past the box were at 25 mph or below.

Description of the suspect: Hispanic male, possibly mid to late 20's, short black hair, typically wears a plain white t-shirt and basketball shorts. Targets women who are walking alone and grabs them from behind groping the victim. Runs away when the woman yells.
