The buildings are the city's former Cultural Arts Center and the former Department of Education building.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Visitation Academy – The Planning Commission meeting on February 13th included a discussion of the zoning change for the Visitation Academy that would remove the institutional overlay and change it to the underlying residential zoning. The Planning Commission will have one more meeting on this zoning change on March 13th. Residents are welcome to attend and voice their concerns about the effect of development on the neighborhood and downtown.
- Alley way speed limit – a few NAC Coordinators will be meeting with city staff to talk about the speed limit in the alley ways and if there is a way to reduce it.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Gas Meter discussion – Carrie Albee and Matt Davis (City of Frederick) were in attendance to talk about meters that are being relocated to the front of businesses and residences. The meters can be read remotely and there is still discussion as to why they are being placed in the front of homes instead of the back, side or inside.

COMMENTS:

- Residents expressed their interest in being involved in the development of the Visitation Academy. Suggestions were offered by residents such as having a poll or survey of ideas and concerns.
- Residents concerned about traffic, parking, and possibility of multiple large projects occurring at the same time (Visitation Academy and Downtown Hotel and Conference Center.
