POLICE REPORT:

Sgt. Beliveau was on hand to discuss any incidents and concerns from residents. The statistics are at the end of the minutes.

Police Report

- 1) Sgt. Beliveau reminded people to call when they see suspicious activity and to ask for a call back from the officer.
- 2) Regarding police statistics for NAC11, the computer reporting system is fixed so that reports of police and criminal activity can be compared to previous months going forward as it used to be.
- 3) Several residents mentioned the continuation of an old problem with teenagers running around at early hours in the morning in North Pointe creating a noise disturbance and hanging out on other people's property.. Sergeant Beliveau said that police do respond to every request. If residents would ask for a follow-up call they do not have to have a home visit, then they would know when the officers actually showed up. If for some reason the follow up call does not come, then call back and ask for a call again.
- 4) One resident reported on the continuing and serious issue of drug activity and Mullinix Park. She said she observed people passed out from drug use and possibly alcohol. She mentioned that there's a lot of drug activity in the pavilions. She noted that some of the people who were using drugs, and passed out were homeless. Sergeant Beliveau said that it's not their policy to move homeless people along as a general rule but any drug use or criminal activity should be reported. Sgt. Beliveau reported the department's efforts with Mullinix Park and the recent increased community uses of the park such as for the summer lunch program. Don't forget to ask for a follow-up call to make sure then officer has responded.
- 5) One residents asked the police to check up on potential criminal activity that occurs behind the soup kitchen.

GUEST SPEAKER

Kara Norman – Downtown Frederick Partnership - The Square Corner

August 2nd is the Public Meeting to discuss the square corner with a goal of making it more pedestrian friendly and more aesthetically appealing. The meeting will be at 6:30 pm at the Delaplaine Visual Arts Center.

Kara Norman – Downtown Frederick Partnership – Live Downtown Symposium

Kara Norman spoke about the Live Downtown initiative which is designed to help increase the number of residents living downtown by 300 by the year 2020. The partnership commissioned a live downtown case study designed to look for ways to help developers remove impediments to increasing downtown density. The symposium concentrated on different policy, legislation and tax incentives to make new and infill downtown development more cost-effective.

Three residents spoke up about the lack of inclusion of the residential community in the initiative. Impact on current residents include parking and traffic were not discussed during the symposium nor mentioned in the report. Several residents asked to have input into these processes because there would be an impact on current residents. The limited amount of parking both on street and in garages, and increased already dense traffic may create difficulty for all residents both current and future residents.
